Accommodation Induction for STUDENT INFORMATION POINT

- It is IMPORTANT to read "living in homestay accommodation" in student information in the welcome pack please.
- Exchange mobile phone numbers with your host to keep in touch easily.
- Monday to Friday you should be provided with breakfast & evening meal.
- Weekends should also include a packed lunch or light lunch at home.
- Try building a relationship based on mutual respect with your host and use courtesy to help this. Try and remember to say pardon, please, thank you, etc. Communicate and let them know your plans, inform them if you do not want a meal or will be staying away overnight.
- Ask your host for anything you need, give them the opportunity to help you; if after that
 there is still a difficulty then we can assist if needed. You can email our Accommodation
 Manager directly or ask on reception or a member of staff to contact her.
- Security of the homestay is very important and you have the responsibility for locking up when leaving in the morning and returning late at night – please be considerate not to disturb your hosts.
- Do not keep key & address together!
- Advice for late at night: stay on main routes, go with a friend, use a taxi if very late, do
 not use headphones, avoid confrontation and remember that large groups draw
 attention.
- Please do not wait until the end of your stay if you are not happy about something; it may be too late for us to help you then.
- Keep any valuables such as money and passport locked in your suitcase in your bedroom; try not to carry too much cash around with you.
- Have a very happy stay with us and be as English as you can!
